Dear Parents/Guardians

At the End of the Day...

As a fair proportion of the playground will soon be taken up with building work, we have been looking at different ways of releasing the children back to your care at the end of each school day. From Monday we are going to trial the following new arrangement:

We ask you to remain towards the Adventure Play area, to allow the children to have sufficient room in which to wait in an organised manner.

Most of the School will line up in classes between where the building work is, or will be, and the parents. The children will be facing the present Adventure Playground.

Birch, Juniper, Aspen & Oak – line up in the half of the playground nearest the Hall – there will be a label with the class name at the front of the line.

Beech, Willow, Cherry & Cedar – line up in the half of the playground furthest from the Hall – there will be a label with the class name at the front of the line.

Sycamore and Ash – we will release the children to go through the class fire doors. Independent walkers from Ash will be at the front of the queue for fast deployment.

Rowan & Larch – walk through to the Foyer for collection. The independent walkers of Rowan will be at the front of the queue for fast deployment.

After School Club Collection

From Monday, pick up from After School Club should be done from the door between the Hall and the Music Lodge. Here you will find a remote door bell. If you are collecting from After School Club, please ring the bell once (it has a really annoying tone) and then step towards the corner of the Music Lodge so that the ladies can see you through the window. They will come and let you in, so that you can sign for and collect your child/ren.


Snow
