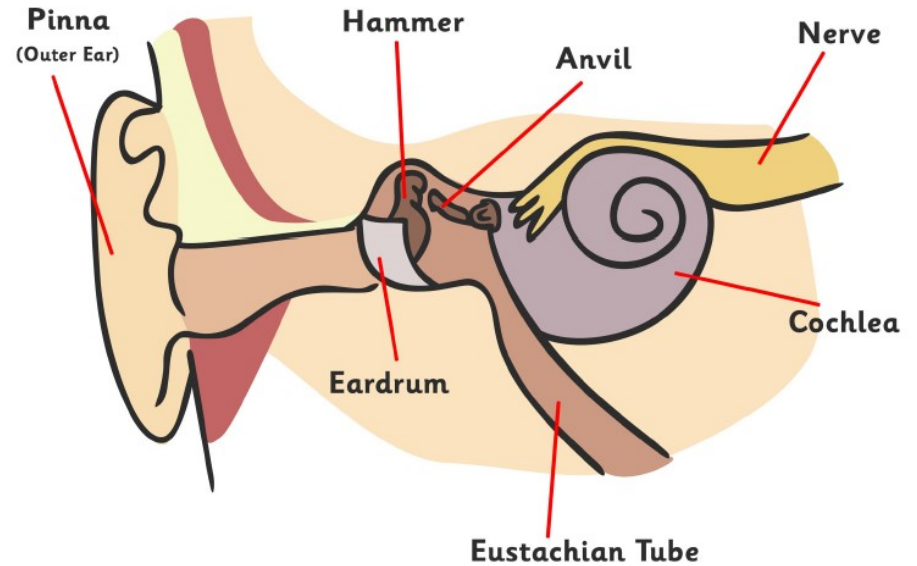


Knowledge Organiser for Year 4—Term 2

Key Scientific Vocabulary	
Loudness	Producing or capable of producing much noise
Volume	The quantity or power of a sound
Vibrate / Vibration	To move continuously and rapidly to and fro
Pitch	The quality of sound governed by the rate of vibrations; the degree of highness or lowness of a tone
Muffle	To wrap or cover to reduce the loudness
Tuning	The action or process of getting an instrument to play in tune
Quiet	Making little or no noise
Soft	Making gentle sounds
Faint	A weak or quiet sound
Decibel	A decibel is a unit of measured used to measure sound
Insulation	The act of using a material to cover something
