<b>Apologies</b> (Who couldn't be at the meeting.)	All present
<b>Agenda Discussion</b> (What we talked about.)	<p>Most children brought their class healthy snacks tally and we compared these to the survey taken in November. All classes has an increase in the number of healthy snacks their class have each day. However, many of us felt that there are still children bringing in crisps.</p> <p>In Oak class, the School Council rep reminds the class each morning and then counts the snacks for the tally.
